1. Download Adobe Digital Editions onto your desktop computer.

2. Create a free Adobe ID.



3. Install Adobe Digital Editions and authorize your computer with an Adobe ID.

Under the *Help* tab, select the *Authorize Computer* option.

Authorize Your Computer

Authorizing your computer enables you to:

- Easily transfer Adobe DRM protected items between multiple computers and mobile devices.
- Read Adobe DRM-protected items on computers or mobile devices (up to six).
- Restore your content from backup whenever you need to re-install the OS.



I clicked “Download ePub” but nothing happened. What do I do?


When you click “Download ePub”, a file called “URLLINK.acsm” will download to your computer. Depending on your browser settings, sometimes a dialogue box will not appear. To locate this file, check your Downloads folder.

If you are using the Google Chrome browser, right-click on the “Download ePub” link and select the “Save link as...” option.




Due to a new security update in Chrome, a message will appear at the bottom saying that the URLLINK.acsm file cannot be downloaded securely. It is a prompt to ask the user that the file you are downloading is safe.

Next to the Discard button, click the arrow and select the “Keep” option to allow the download to continue.




4. Save the URLLINK.acsm file to a location of your choosing.



5. Open Adobe Digital Editions and navigate to the downloaded URLLINK.acsm file (this is usually in your Downloads folder).

Drag the URLLINK.acsm file directly into the open Adobe Digital Editions window.



6. Your ePlay should now appear in your Adobe Digital Editions library. Enjoy your ePlay!
